**Subject: update Covid-19**



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Just a few more days and then the summer holidays will be over. Hopefully you were able to enjoy this period in good health.

As you have been able to follow in the media, the Covid-19 virus is still abundant and the number of infections is rising again. In order to be able to start again as carefully and safely as possible, we would like to point out the measures below.

**1. All pupils go fully to school after the summer holidays.**

Have you been in an area marked "code orange" less than 2 weeks ago? You report this to the teacher of your child (ren). Your child does not have to stay at home and will therefore come to school. Unfortunately, all adults and older brothers and sisters (over 12 years old) are not allowed in the playground and in the school. This means that your child must be taken to school by someone else outside the family. This applies until the 2 weeks of quarantine are over and no complaints have arisen. For more information:

**2.** Children up to and including 6 years old with a runny nose (without any doubt) are allowed to come to school. Children with hay fever complaints are also welcome if you are sure that these are the well-known hay fever complaints. When in doubt, always stay at home and have it tested.

**3.** In principle, parent (s) / caregiver (s) do not come into the school. In the schoolyard, a distance of 1.5 meters must be kept during the pick-up and drop-off times.

**4.** Provided at the request of the school and after strict triage, individual parents may re-enter the school in specific situations.

**5.** There is no need to keep a 1.5 meter distance between students.

**6.** There is no need to maintain a 1.5 meter distance between staff members and the student.

**7.** A distance of 1.5 meters must be maintained between staff members, unless close contact is necessary for the work.

**8.** Gym classes may again be given in the gym.

**9.** The school ensures that students wash their hands often.

**10.** After school everyone goes straight home or the BSO.

**11.** School trips and camp will not take place in the coming period.
